



## **SAN DIEGO CREW CLASSIC® – March 27 & 28 2010 TENT LAWN GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Tent Lawn has easy access to the course so patrons can view racing and where athletes and spectators enjoy hospitality and camaraderie.

20' by 20' tents are provided by the Crew Classic® for \$600 per tent.

Tent patrons may bring their own food. Nearby are: food court, merchandise tents, Trade Show, beer garden, and a Jumbotron showing the races from start to finish. On-site concessionaire can deliver simple or elaborate fare to meet the organizations' needs.

**Collegiate Finals early on Sunday:** The finals of the Collegiate Copley Cup (men) and Jessop/Whittier Cup (women) will be raced before 9:30 a.m. Be sure to tell your guests. Check the website for the updated schedule with lane draws approximately two weeks in advance: [www.crewclassic.org](http://www.crewclassic.org).

**Alcohol:** A city ordinance prohibits distribution of alcohol in the alumni tents. We do however, have a special beer garden in the alumni tent area with a great view of the races. We offer drink tickets at a special price for you to distribute to your guests.

**IMPORTANT RESTRICTION:** Selling of food and beverages to the public by those in Tent Row is NOT covered under our event permit. Any organizations wishing to do this must submit forms and secure permits from the City of San Diego and be included in our concession program. We can handle that for you, just let us know.

**Firm enforcement of City laws by the City of San Diego is anticipated. Organizations may sell tickets for admission to the groups' party. Selling food to the general public on-site is not allowed. You may charge your members to attend but you may not take cash from the general public at the event for any items you maybe offering.**

**City ordinance prohibits use of glass containers of any kind.**

**Tents:** The cost of a 20' by 20' tent for the whole weekend is \$600. This is what it costs the Crew Classic – there is **NO** profit. Included are 2 banquet tables, 20 chairs, white picket fence, and nearby live race coverage on the Jumbotron. Electricity will be available for a fee. We are negotiating electrical costs at this time. To obtain extra equipment, see the Furnishings & Equipment Form below.

**Preferred Parking and Entrance:** Parking near the venue gates is \$10.00 per car per day and the entrance fee is \$7 for one day; children under 13 are admitted free. The south ("green") lot is closest to the Tent Lawn. By order of the Police Department, no cars or trucks will be allowed in by the tents after 7 AM, but with some notice, our carts are available to help with unloading. **Free parking** is available at Ski Beach on Vacation Island, just south of Crown Point, with free shuttle transportation to and from the Regatta venue.

The venue is turned over to us to run the Crew Classic<sup>®</sup> but we are subject to City Park rules and City ordinances. We are required to have two San Diego Police Department officers on site during the event and they will assist in enforcing the rules.

1. Everyone pays to park and enter the event unless they have a pass.
2. NO BIKES (lock them to the outside of the perimeter fence). City ordinance. Police will enforce this rule.
3. NO SKATES (may carry them). City ordinance.
4. NO DOGS or other pets (except guide dogs) including in the parking lots. City ordinance.
5. NO GLASS BOTTLES or glass containers of any kind. City ordinance.
6. NO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL OUTSIDE DESIGNATED AREAS. City ordinance.
6. NO SELLING OF ALCOHOL TO ANYONE. Firm enforcement of this law by the City of San Diego is anticipated.
7. NO SELLING OF FOOD TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC. As stated above, alumni groups and clubs may sell tickets for admission to the groups' party.
8. NO BALLOONS. City ordinance.
9. NO AMPLIFIERS. City ordinance
