



The city of San Diego has been bustling and beginning to return to its usual state, filled with wonderful attractions for all to enjoy. Although we are still navigating through the COVID-19 protocols, there are a lot of fun and safe ways to spend your time in San Diego this summer with proper precautions. For example...









- **Comic-Con** is next weekend, July 21-24th at the San Diego Convention Center! This international comic book convention has been around since 1970, and this will be their first in-person event since 2019. Welcome back Comic-Con!
- It's impossible to forget about Balboa Park when discussing all the various activities San Diego has to offer. The Monet to Matisse: Impressionist Masterpieces from the Bemberg Foundation exhibition is running at the San Diego Museum of Art (located in Balboa Park) through August 7th, 2022. This will be the first time that Georges Bemberg's extensive and impressive fine arts collection will be in California, so it is a must see!

One of two wins at the 2022 SDCC, this crew endured a powerful battle against UCLA and USC before pulling ahead in the last 100 meters. Coxed by **Mo Guild** and stroked by **Cameron Herrera**, this was the first Novice 8+ win for the team since 1989.

San Diego Rowing Club's Azja Czajkowksi just made Team USA's U23 Women's 8+ ! U23 Selection Camp was hosted by the University of Virginia and coached by Kevin Sauer this year. Azja earned an invite through her impressive rowing resume, including winning silver in the Women's 8+ at the 2018 World Rowing Junior Championships and finishing second in the 1V8+ and team standings with Stanford Women's Crew at the 2021 and 2022 NCAAs. This year is the first ever combined U23 and U19 World Championships, held in Varese, Italy from July 25th - 31st.
